 discharge my debts and charge whatsoever further Item I Ordaine
 Alexander Norrish and John Drake my sonne to be my Executors
 trust to see this my last will and Testament fullfilled In witness
 whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and sealed John Drake
 confirmed and sealed in the presence of us Testes John Drake
 the signe of Elinor Magridy

This will was proved at **Westminster**

the eight day of August in the year of our Lord God One thousand
 six hundred fifty and four before the Judges for probate of wills
 and granting Administrations lawfully authorized by the oath
 of Alexander Drake the naturall and lawfull sonne and sole
 Executor named in the above written Will to whom Administration
 of all and singular the goodd Chattells and debt of the said deceased
 was committed he being first lawfully sworn (by virtue of a Commis-
 sion truly and faithfully to administer the same)

I **Mistress Mary Jacob** the **Elder** of the Parish of **Canisford**
 in the Countie of **Devon** widow being weak of body out of sort of
 memory than ever began into Almighty God And for the falling
 of years and quietnes after my decease do here make ordaine and
 declare this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following
 (in debilit) first I Comend my soule into the hands of Almighty
 God my Treasour knowing an assured trust and Confidence through
 the only merits of **Jesus Christ** my Saviour and Redeemer to
 have remission of all my finnes and to be partaker of his heavenly
 Kingdome And my body I Comitt to the Earth till that dayfull
 day of the resurrection when both my soule and body shall be reunited
 and dwell with my Saviour for evermore Item I give and bequeth to
 the poore People of **Canisford** afore said three poundes Item I
 and bequeth unto **John Jacob** my sonne Twenty poundes Item I
 give and bequeth unto **Edward Jacob** my sonne three poundes
 Item I give and bequeth unto **John Jacob** my Grandchild tenne
 poundes and my former best bed or former best sheet and pillow
 Item I give and bequeth unto **Mary Jacob** and **Honour**
 Jacob my Grandchildren tenne poundes apiece Item I give and
 bequeth unto **Agnes Jacob** **Edmond Jacob** **Johan Jacob** **Mary**
 and the younger **Bartholomew Jacob** and **Margarett Jacob** my
 Grandchildren to each of them five poundes apiece Item I give
 and bequeth to **Elinor Jacob** and **Francis Jacob** my
 Grandchildren

Two shillings and six pence apiece John J. give and bequeath
 into Edward Jacob and Jane Jacob my Grandchildren some and
 daughter of Edward my forsaie some five shillings apiece John
 J. give and bequeath to Elmer Storkman my servant two shillings and
 six pence All which forsaie Legacies be fore given my Will intent and
 meaning is to be paid as soon as my Executor hereafter named
 shall with convenient revibe and revibe in all such debts and special
 ties as are due unto me and not be fore the revibe thereof All the
 rest of my goods and Chattells not be fore given nor bequeathed I doo
 here by give and bequeath unto Richard Jacob my Grandchild some
 of John Jacob my some a few names whom I ordain and make my
 whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and doo
 hereby revoke and disanulle all former Wills and Legacies what so ever
 John J. give unto Richard Crowto for writing of this my Will Twentie
 shillings And I doo desire John Jacob my some a forsaie to be my
 Overseer of this my Will according to the true intent and meaning hereof
 In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seale the
 the one and twentieth day of November Anno Domini One thousand six
 hundred forty eight Signum M^{rs} Mary Jacob the Elder Sealed and
 published in the presence of Richard Crowto Tho: Raddall Tho: Rigne
 of Gaffer Raddall

The seven tenth day of July in the year
 of our Lord God One thousand six hundred fiftie and four by the
 Judges for probate of Wills and granting Administrations lawfully autho-
 rized Administration issued forth to Elizabeth Jacob the natural and
 lawfull Mother and Curatrix lawfully assigned of Richard Jacob a
 Minor the natural and lawfull Grandchild and sole Executor of Mary
 Jacob late of Cambridge in the County of Devon deceased to administ
 the goods Chattells and debts of the said deceased according to the
 tenor and effect of the deceased Will and during the minority and
 to the use and benefit of the said Richard the Executor the being
 first legally sworn by virtue of a Commission truly and faithfully to
 administer the same

 good and perfect remembrance (revoke and disanulling all former Wills and

 body to Christian buriall John J. give unto my daughter Katherine Wintcombe
 the summe of thirty poundes besides the tenne she hath had according to my
 promise in marriage to her to be paid by my Executor within twelve monthes
 my decease John J. give unto John J. give unto my daughter Anne Burleigham
 the summe of Twentie poundes to be left in my Executors trust hands for her good
 and not paid unto her husband except the five poundes only and that to be
 paid by my Executor within twelve monthes after my decease the other twenty
 poundes to be putt out by shroind in trust for my daughters good John J. give unto
 my daughter Marshall Molluish the summe of thirty poundes besides what
 she hath already to be paid to her within twelve monthes after my decease
 by my Executor John J. give to my some James Geston the summe of thirty
 poundes
